

Data Summary from Summer 2009
NADAA Coalition Member Surveys

16 responded to the online survey

#1 – importance of monthly meetings: 80% “very important” or “important” – the members do think the monthly meetings are relevant for them

#2 – frequency: 73% like monthly – a pretty solid indication to continue with monthly meetings

#3 – day of the week to meet: - all over, with Wednesday having about 1/3 of choices. You might think about varying the days or suggest that to coalition to see what they think.

#4 – best time: 2/3 liked either after school or evening, only 3 over lunch. You might want to suggest meetings later in the day or early evening.

#5 – agendas: they liked the balance of information and discussion (93%).

#6 – reasons for not attending: scheduling conflicts (93%). With this and #3 and #4, might talk about varying days and times to meet (you have to decide between consistency and flexibility)

#7 – lunch paid/unpaid: not really an issue with this group

#8 – tasks/duties: balance among recruitment, volunteering, leadership and participation. No one area really jumped out. It seems this group like the variety of services/activities.

#9 – functions: no one area really overrode the others. You have a group that can serve multiple functions and seems to like it.

#10 – Comments: several positive comments, but most concerned meeting attendance.
